Introductions - Round table introductions.

1) New Business

- Review of January school council's meeting minutes for approval.
- Blair motion to approve

2) Principals Report Bulletin:

- Rosie, (the music teacher), presented band camp Nakamun to the parent council and is looking for monetary support for the upcoming trip. The camp provides technique and skills training, builds students repertoire, helps build ensemble within the band and is an overall fun and memorable experience that boosts motivation and enthusiasm amongst the students. 49 students are to attend on April 7-8 and stay overnight, cost will be \$2184.

- Budget review for the school, currently \$231,000 in the bank. 1217 enrolled with 3 new students after spring break. 1157 enrolled for next year's school year at CTK. Anticipated plan is to have three grade 1 classrooms with 22 students per classroom.
- CTK is building a Complexity Team. They have hired a Behaviouralist, remaining of the team will be resourced by current teacher/skill sets to complete the team.
- There is a new curriculum to be rolled out. Social and Math have been revised and Health will be a part of Gym. Additionally, Financial Literacy will be added and will be one block a week. The pilot year will be 2026-2027.
- June 9th will be the Grade 9 farewell. The students will be able to invite 2 guests per student. The students can bring their guests to church and back to the school for dinner. The cost will be \$50 per family.
- June 17th will be Elementary Fun Day.
- Facilities came to clean up the school. There will be some new landscaping with cement at the east doors, new bike racks and new turf. The hose bibs will be functioning and an asphalt pathway will help level out the back doors. Kelly located the drain at the back of the school which has helped with the new renovations to the school. Landscaping company to come in and take care of the invasive species. Portables and washrooms to be added to the back of the school and enclose the breeze way.
- Kelly took the teachers and parent council on a tour of the sensory room/beacon rooms.

Cheer Presentation:

Elementary and junior high students need new uniforms. They are worn down, gems and stones missing. Elementary is first priority, junior is second, hoping for both teams to get new uniforms.
